



## 2011 GULF COAST COUNCIL “CAMP CARD” CAMPAIGN

### - POLICIES -

- The idea of “Camp Cards” is to help Scouts earn their own way to camp, purchase uniforms, camping equipment or any of their Scouting needs. This is a unit decision. Units can decide to use the campaign to raise unit income instead of income for the Scouts (It is proven though, that motivating Scouts and their families to sell for offsetting their personal cost of scouting works). The council does not keep individual Scout accounts for Camp Card funds to be held.
- \$2.50 of every \$5.00 camp card sold goes to the Scout, the remaining \$2.50 goes to the Gulf Coast Council. The council provides cards to units selling cards and also provides the “On My Honor” cash prize program at no cost to your unit.
- Units ***must*** designate only one person for their unit to handle pick-up, payments and additional card requests. The commitment form must be completed and returned to your District Executive.
- The unit must pay \$2.50 per card for all cards checked out before additional cards will be issued.
- ***Unit is responsible for all lost or broken cards.***
- Units must clear out all due payments and return all unsold cards no later than June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.
- Units are responsible for setting up sale locations or door to door sales. Remember, **Two Deep Adult Leadership** is a must for Scouts selling camp cards.
