WRFA- The American Red Cross Wilderness and Remote First Aid training course is for those who work, live or play in remote areas - away from usual emergency medical services. Even though the emergency workers near these areas may be trained to search for and rescue those in need, there may be a delay in the notification of assistance, the time required to get to the patient, or in moving the patient to more advanced treatment. This course helps provide the knowledge and skills necessary to deal with these emergencies until more advanced care can be provided.

You will need to be certified in CPR/AED prior to attending this training.

Wilderness and Remote First Aid Training is a 16-hour training course offered by the Gulf Coast Council and certified by the American Red Cross.

It is now required for Philmont Scout Ranch and other BSA high adventure programs and fulfills the core first aid requirement for the Venturing Ranger Award. This course will be conducted both in a classroom setting and participation in outdoor practice scenarios. This will be a fast paced, intense learning situation recommended for adults and mature youth, minimum age 14 years. Minors must be accompanied by parent/guardian or their unit leader.
