Spanish Trail Scout Reservation is about 7 miles west of DeFuniak Springs off Hwy 90. From the west Exit 70 (old 13) go north and turn right on Hwy 90. Turn right on Boy Scout Road. From the east Exit 85 (Old 14) go north through DeFuniak Springs and turn left on Hwy 90. Turn left on Boy Scout Road. There is a large road sign that points to Boy Scout Road. Once on Boy Scout Road turn left at the stone gate and proceed across the lake to Henson Hall.
