

Leader Notes on New Delivery Method

1. BSA has a new meeting plan for each rank. All scout units across the nation will be using it for consistency and to promote advancement. This is a great advantage to the leaders who plan and any youth who move during the year.

2. All ranks have a 16 meeting plan for use during the school year. It involves two 1.5 hour meetings, a field trip and if followed allows all scouts to earn their rank in February at Blue & Gold Banquets. There is a supplemental plan to be used if you meet more than twice a month.





3. All meetings have an agenda including the supply list, requirements covered, homework to be assigned (family involved requirements) and details needed for den leaders to be successful.

4. The Den 16 Meeting Plan and Specific Meeting Agendas can be used to help recruit leaders. Easy to follow plan for everyone.

5. The meetings will follow a theme based on the 10 Purposes of Cub Scouting, one for each month of the year.

5. Special note for Den Leaders of 5th grade WEBELOS who have already done some activity badges... Start with the WEBELOS Meeting Plan, review each week and do the activities you haven't already done. Once you have completed all of those, move on to the Arrow of Light Meeting Plans to finish the year.
